### CRIMINAL COMPLAINT

#### CHARGES:

- Child solicitation by electronic communication device and meets with child (child 13 to 16)
- Statute: 30-37-03.2(A) & (C)(1)
- Code: 6709
- That on or about the 09 day of October, 2024, the above named defendant in the City of Albuquerque, Bernalillo County, State of New Mexico, the above named defendant knowingly and intentionally solicited, a child at least thirteen but less than sixteen years of age, by means of an electronic communication device to engage in sexual intercourse, sexual contact, a sexual or obscene performance, or any other sexual conduct and the defendant was at least four years older than the child and the defendant appeared for, attended or was present at a meeting that he/she arranged pursuant to the solicitation, a third degree felony, contrary to NMSA 1978, Section 30-37-3.2 (2007)

AND

- Criminal Sexual Penetration (2nd Degree) (Child 13-18) (Force or Coercion) - attempt
- Statute: 30-09-11(E)(1) & 30-28-01
- Code: 4937
- Language: That on or about the 09 day of October, 2024, the above-named defendant in City of Albuquerque, Bernalillo County, State of New Mexico did attempt to commit Felony, to wit: Criminal Sexual Penetration in the Second Degree (Child Age 13-18), in that the defendant intended to commit a Felony, to wit: Criminal Sexual Penetration in the Second Degree (Child Age 13-18), and began to do an act which constituted a substantial part of Felony, to wit: Criminal Sexual Penetration in the Second Degree (Child Age 13-18), but failed to commit

the offense, a third degree felony, contrary to NMSA 1978, Sections 30-9-11(E)(1) (2009) and 30-28-1 (1963).

AND

- Sexual exploitation of children by prostitution
- Statute: 30-6A-4.B
- Language: That on or about the 09 day of October 2024, the above named defendant in the City of Albuquerque, Bernalillo County, State of New Mexico did attempt to commit a felony, to wit: Any person hiring or offering to hire a child over the age of thirteen and under the age of sixteen to engage in any prohibited sexual act is a second degree felony.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE:

On October 08, 2024, a sworn-certified Albuquerque Police Department (APD) detective posed as a fifteen-year-old female juvenile for an undercover chat operation. Mahmoud Telfah met the fifteen-year-old on Skip the Games, ad. The ad had a telephone number to contact the female. Mahmoud continued the conversation via text from the phone number on the Skip the Games ad.

In the conversation on October 8th, the undercover detective gives out that they are fifteen years old, to Mahmoud. Mahmoud reached out to the undercover detective, who then let Mahmoud know that they are younger than the post says. Mahmoud then said "so?" The undercover detective responded asking so what, to which Mahmoud responded "how much, hand j." Based on my training and experience, hand J means hand job. During part of the conversation, Mahmoud ask "how much if I want everything?" The undercover replies with "...if you want more 100 for bj 150 for condom sex." Through My training and experience bj means blow job. Undercover detective advises they are 15, and Mahmoud asked if the undercover was police. The undercover says they are not a fed, and Mahmoud asks about how he can trust the undercover detective, prompting the undercover detective to send a picture. Mahmoud again ask how much. Through further conversation a price was agreed upon. Mahmoud asked for a location, and again the undercover advised their age being 15. The conversation between the two agrees on meeting tomorrow.

Tuesday, October 9<sup>th</sup>, the conversation continues with the undercover and Mahmoud speaking. During the conversation an agreement to meet is made. Mahmoud arrives at and parks in front of the location, which is located in Albuquerque, New Mexico, where he was taken into custody by law enforcement officials.
